What will we be doing?

Below is an outline of what our day will look like:

Time	Activity
10am Registration	Welcome and Icebreakers
10.20am Sport	Sport specific sessions, typically football, basketball, dodgeball, or ballon tennis
11am Break	Refillable water bottles are required
11.10am Games	Games, Endball, Captue the Flag, Tag Games, Floor is Lava, Scavenger Hunt etc
11.50am Enrichment activities	Salt painting, seed planting, clay modelling, food portraits, spaghetti tower etc.
12.30pm Lunch	Provided by our external caterers and delivered fresh to site.
1pm Arts and Crafts/Quizzes	Post lunch children will take part in colouring or painting sessions or quizzes using our Brainbox packs.
1.30pm Sports or Games	The final session of the day will get everyone running around with games such and domes and cones, benchball, obstacle courses, or a tournament!
1.55pm Sign out	A group tidy up followed by signing out at the end of the day.
