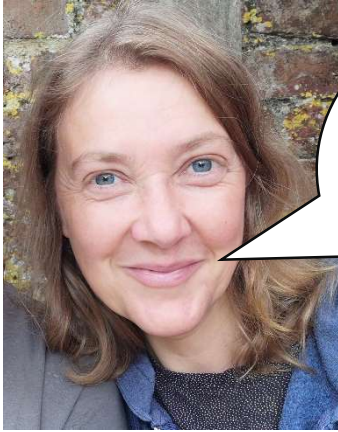


# All About Us! Kendal Road Baptist Church

## Where are we?



This is our front entrance. There is a small step although we do have a flat side entrance if you need it.



We have a small courtyard with some outside toys.



This is our back hall where we will have our lunch.



This is our middle hall which we sometimes have set up for younger brothers and sisters who come along.



This is the main room where we will have lots of craft activities, games and competitions. We will also have The School of Larks coming to teach us some circus skills.



Sometimes we go outside to a public space over the road from the church. We do have a ramp as there is a curb.

## Accessibility Information

**Disabled parking:** we have two disabled parking spaces

**Access:** we have a small step into the building. However, we also have a side entrance which is flat and wheelchair and buggy friendly.

**Disabled toilets:** We have two disabled toilets, one in our entrance foyer and another with the other toilets which has a baby changing area. Unfortunately, we do not have facilities for older children.

**Quiet space/sensory area:** We have a small quiet room equipped with sensory toys, bean bags, cuddly toys, colouring and picture books.
